Principles (1/2)






- §58.1(c) of the FR allows implementation of budget through Indirect Management
- Provisions of §60 FR needs to be respected
 - Procurement rules
 - Budget Control/Accounting
 - etc.

Principles (2/2)







Commission <u>remains</u> responsible for implementation of the budget

EE performs entrusted budget implementation tasks, controls contract relationship


Contractor

Service provider as contractor is liable for providing the contracted deliverables/ product





Entrusted Entities (2/2)





- > These entities...
 - ...are identified in the Copernicus Regulation; (EEA, Frontex, EMSA, ECMWF)
 - ...have emerged from an Expression of Interest; (ECMWF, Mercator Océan)
- > §60 FR Audit as applicable ("4Pillars review")
- Changes to procedures agreed as needed.

Delegation Decision (1/3)





> The Delegation Decision

- identifies the proposed Entrusted Entity per service area concerned;
- sets a maximum amount to be delegated to each Entrusted Entity;
- authorises the DG to negotiate and sign a delegation agreement, after having informed the members of the Commission.

NB: §11.3 of the Copernicus Regulation:

"The Committee will be informed in advance of the delegation agreements to be concluded [...]"

Delegation Decision (2/3)





> The Implementation Framework

- gives the main elements of the Delegation Agreement texts to be negotiated;
- is similar for all service delegation agreements;
- is derived from the model contracts existing for other domains (development aid, etc.);

Main aspects addressed are:

- Procurement rules;
- Reporting / monitoring mechanisms;
- Control mechanisms;
- Ownership / IPR
- Performance Indicators

Delegation Decision (3/3)





> The Technical Annex

- ➤ Is in line with the Implementation Plan annexed to the Copernicus Work Programme
- describes the scope of the delegated tasks;
 - General budget implementation tasks expected from the Entrusted Entities;
 - Scope of the technical tasks per service area concerned;
- serves as a starting point for the Technical Annexes of the Delegation Agreemnets;
